Rules

The rules are simple, starting with the English FA Premiership fixture list on Saturday 11h of February, choose the team you think will definitely win. Win and you go through to the next round, lose or draw and you are out. If you win the next set of fixtures will be emailed to you and you will be asked to pick your team. You will not be allowed to pick the same team twice.

Registration for the first round of the Last Man Standing competition closes at 11am on Saturday 11th of February.

Once your entry has been received you will receive an email requesting your team for the first round of fixtures and before each round of fixtures in the future, provided you are successful in the previous round.

For just one round of fixtures you are allowed to nominate the win AND the draw. This means that if you select Team A with Draw and Team A wins or draws then you are through to the next round.

All selections must be received no later than midday on the day of the first match of the week. For midweek rounds where the first game kicks off at 7.45pm or later, all selections must be in by 7pm.

Should you forget to make your selection in any week, you will automatically be assigned the first team you have not selected in alphabetical order. Once a team is automatically selected, you will not have the ability to change the selection.

Should two or more participants remain standing and are all eliminated in the same week, the Last Man Standing prize will be distributed equally among them.
